The <u>Coffalyser.Net Installation Manual</u> contains detailed, step-by-step instructions to update Coffalyser.Net. Important

Before starting, make sure to read the important notes about updating in the <u>installation</u> manual.

The general procedure consists of the following steps:

- <u>Downloading</u> the latest version of Coffalyser.Net.
- Making a note of the current configuration of Coffalyser.Net.
- Uninstalling the old version of Coffalyser.Net (not of Microsoft SQL Server).
- Installing the latest version of Coffalyser.Net. Note that Coffalyser.Net can be updated to the latest version from any previous version it is *not* necessary to update to an intermediate version first.
- Making a backup of the database (not required but recommended).
- Configuring the latest version of Coffalyser.Net to connect to your existing data.

See the <u>installation manual</u> for more details. This procedure requires administrative rights on the computer, which may require assistance from your IT department.
